

Provincial Violence Prevention Curriculum for Physicians – Now Complete!

The Provincial Violence Prevention Curriculum (PVPC) for Physicians is a 1.5-hour eLearning course. It is based on four main responsibilities in preventing and protecting against violence in the workplace - the PVPC Framework:

- 1. Recognize Risks and Behaviours
- 2. Assess and Plan
- 3. Respond to the Risk
- 4. Report and Communicate Post-Incident
