*Understanding this non-linear process*

A Point of Care Risk Assessment is a non-linear process.

Ask questions like the ones below throughout patient interactions to help you decide if it's safe.



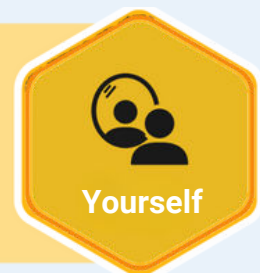
- What do I need to know about this person?
- What do I see and hear?
- Is there a change in behaviour?



- Do I have a safe exit?
- Is there a way to get help nearby?
- Have I looked for potential hazards?



- Is my task likely to cause pain or distress?
- Does it need to be done right now?
- What is the person's reaction to this task?



- Am I tired, angry, hungry, or frustrated?
- Could anything I am wearing be grabbed?
- Do I feel safe to continue?
