


# Violence Risk Alerts

*What to consider while providing care*

A Violence Risk Alert is a communication tool that reminds workers to stop and check for more information before proceeding with patient care. It is not a label for a patient and it doesn't always mean they will be violent in the future.

## ***If you see a Violence Risk Alert:***

- **Pause** and set aside any biases.
- **Review** the Behavioural Care Plan.
- **Complete** your task.
- **Reassess** and adjust if needed.
- **Ask** for more information if you need it.
